



Who are we?


- Former Coalition for a Clean Parliament (2004, 2007, 2008) monitored integrity of MP and MEP candidates

- Former coalition for Clean Universities (2009, 2010)







- Journalists associations and individuals


And partner institutions (National Anticorruption Agency, National Integrity Agency) on whose capacity development we also work

Why now?

- 15 countries research of Romanian **Academic Society** on behalf of Open Society Institute finds only 3% have volunteer work in donors funded projects and only 8% are disclosures
- Widespread feelings of skepticism 'anticorruption failed', low whistleblowing
- Persistence of corrupt behavior despite raise in legal risks (mayors)

What is to be done?

- Build active watchdog community
- Build integrity community with a public character (businesses)

Increase passive participation to diminish tolerance to corruption (voting for corrupt politicians, tolerating 'pork' and appointment of political clients even in low level positions (library)

What are the premises?

- Many people complain in surveys, but they are afraid to expose themselves and be isolated provide examples of action. 'Business alliance for integrity'
- Many people complain they do not know what do to – provide behavior templates on a regular base
- Skepticism about follow up provide concrete follow ups to every intervention: personal advice, guiding disclosure to authorities and following it, media_disclosure
